Please verify that you have not exceeded the notification period before you proceed.

Royalty Owner (any owner of gas or oil in place, or owner of gas or oil rights, who is eligible to receive payment based on the production of gas or oil)

The drilling unit or drilling location is above or in close proximity to a mine opening or shaft, entry, travelway, airway, haulageway, drainageway or passageway, or to any proposed extension thereof, in any operated or abandoned or operating mineral mine, or in any mineral mine already surveyed and platted but not yet being operated.
