


SAFETY ALERT BULLETIN SLIP AND FALL



On February 15, 2010, at approximately 6:15AM, a serious injury occurred to a miner while walking from the parking lot to the mine site.

The injured miner was walking up an illuminated flight of stairs when he fell approximately 15 feet backwards to the ground. There were no witnesses to the accident although a fellow miner was a short distance behind and rendered assistance. The injured miner was transported to the hospital. He sustained injuries to his back and neck..

- When walking up or down steps always use the handrails.
- During inclement weather, always keep stairways and walkways clear of snow and ice.
- Provide proper lighting in areas traveled at night and during early morning hours.
